## Booking Mass Intentions (What is allowed?)

When booking a Mass on Wednesday's or Friday's, one person may book *up to 3 names* per Mass Intention. (ie, + Jane, John & Mary Doe) this would be one Mass Intention for one designated Mass. Multiple Mass Intentions means multiple people can book Mass Intentions when there is already an intention on Wednesdays or Fridays as another intention: (ie. Wed, Mar. 25: 1. + Jane, ... ; 2. *Bob Moss (thanksgiving)*; 3. *Billy & Marcus Ruth (Wed. Anniv.)* etc for that one Wednesday or Friday Mass). Please also specify with a comma if it is multiple names (up to 3) or one name. Please book the intention with First & Last name only. Thank you!

## What's Happening in our Parish?

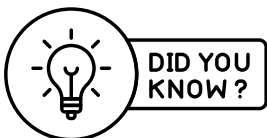


Our Young Adults have hosted a few events to encourage 'Sanctas Communitas'! If you would like to join a future event, please feel free to join!

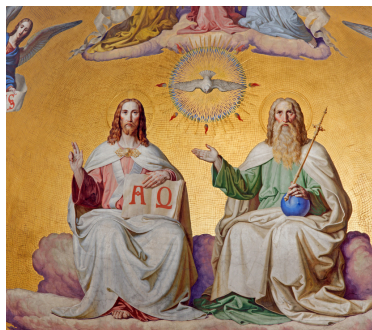
